KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That George H. Burton (also known as Geo. H. Burton) and Sarah Burton, husband and wife Grantees of Klamath County, State of Oregon, in consideration of TEN AND NO/100 Dollars to them paid by Herbert A. Salisbury and Mary D. Salisbury, husband and wife Grantees of Klamath County, State of Oregon, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Grantees, their heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situated in the County of Klamath and State of Oregon:

A parcel of land situate in the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, T. 39 S., R. 9 E., W. M. particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point marked by an iron pin driven in the ground in the center line of a 60 foot roadway from which the section corner common to Sections 2, 3, 10 and 11, Twp. 39 S., R. 9 E., W. M. bears South 89 deg. 44' West along the center line of said roadway a distance of 104.4 feet to a point in the West boundary of said Section 11, and North 0 deg. 13' West along the section line 1662.5 feet; running thence South 0 deg. 7' East 331.75 feet to a point in the Southerly boundary of the said N $\frac{1}{2}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 11; thence North 89 deg. 42' East along said boundary line 67.5 feet; thence North 0 deg. 7' West 331.7 feet more or less to the center line of said roadway; thence South 89 deg. 44' West along the center line of the said roadway, 67.6 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

SUBJECT: however, to the following easements and reservations:-

1. Easement for one-half of the right of way of the above mentioned 60 foot roadway.
2. An easement for ditches and/or pipe lines to convey water for irrigation and domestic use, and for drainage purposes, for the benefit of adjoining property owners.
3. That no dwelling house shall be placed upon said land to cost less than \$1000.00; that such dwelling shall be finished in a workmanlike manner and shall be painted outside; that all buildings shall be set back at least 60 feet from the center line of the above mentioned roadway.

together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all their estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the said Herbert A. Salisbury and Mary D. Salisbury, husband and wife, their

heirs and assigns forever. And the Grantors above named, do covenant to and with the above named Grantees, their heirs and assigns, that they lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, that the above granted premises are free from all encumbrances.

and that they will and their heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and forever defend the same, and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
