IN RE CONTRACT, dated June 30, 1918, made by Ruech A. Karl and
Irene Minnie Karl, involving purchase of 1.75 acres of land, for \$ 150.00
purpose for right-of-way for the Lost River Diversion Channel enlargement.

1. The land described in the above-named contract is necessary for the purpose stated, and the consideration is reasonable. Land of a similar character in the vicinity has sold recently for \$ 325.00 per acre.

2. The land was entered Sept. 8, 1866 under the State Selection law.
