

ORDER REMOVING RESTRICTIONS

WHEREAS, by a warranty deed dated August 7, 1927, and recorded in Indian Office Miscellaneous Deed Book Vol. 23, Page 112, RUFUS HICKS, an Indian of the Klamath Reservation, acquired from Richard A. Sanders and Amy L. Sanders, husband and wife, non-Indian, land described as LOT TWELVE (12) IN BLOCK FOUR (4) IN THE FIRST ADDITION TO CHILOQUIN, OREGON, AS PER PLAT ON FILE IN THE COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE IN KLAMATH COUNTY, OREGON, subject to the condition that when the title is in the grantee or heirs, no sale or encumbrance thereof shall be valid without the consent of the Secretary of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, the owner has applied to have the restrictions against the sale or encumbrance of the above-described land removed and upon examination, consideration, and investigation, it is found that the best interests of the applicant will be served by removing the restrictions from the above-described property;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the provisions of the instrument of conveyance and authority conferred on the Area Director by Secretarial Order No. 2508 of January 11, 1949 (16 F. R. 258), and Order No. 551 of the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, dated March 29, 1951 (16 F. R. 2939), the restrictions or encumbrances on the above-described land are hereby removed.
