ORDINANCE NO. 178

AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING A STRIP OF REAL ESTATE, APPROXIMATELY TWENTY FEET IN WIDTH OFF OF BLOCK SEVEN, TERRACES ADDITION, TO CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON, LYING NEXT TO DAMONT STREET, FOR A PUBLIC STREET FOR USE BY THE PUBLIC, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I.

That heretofore the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, being owner of the tract hereinafter described, has allowed it to be used by the public for street purposes and now desires to dedicate it for that purpose; therefore, the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, does hereby dedicate to the public and its use as a street, the territory within the bounds of the following description, to-wit: Situated in the City of Klamath Falls, Klamath County, Oregon;

Beginning at the northeast corner of Block 7 of the Terraces Addition to the City of Klamath Falls, Klamath County, Oregon; thence South 21° 14' East along the westerly line of Damont Street a distance of 185.2 feet to the southwest corner of Block 7; thence North 89° 29' West along the northerly line of Shasta View Street a distance of 21.53 feet to an iron pin; thence North 21° 14' West along a line parallel with the westerly line of Damont Street a distance of 177.22 feet to an iron pin on the southerly line of Huron Street; thence North 68° 46' East along said southerly line of Huron Street a distance of 20 feet to the point of beginning. Being a portion of Lots 1, 2 and 3 of Block 7, Terraces Addition to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon.

Section II.

That the Police Judge of said City is hereby directed to deliver certified copies of this ordinance to the following County officials of Klamath County, Oregon, to-wit: The County Clerk for recording in deed records; the County Assessor and County Engineer, for use in their respective offices.

Section III.

The immediate use of this territory for street purposes, being urgent; the immediate enactment of this ordinance is deemed necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in the case of this ordinance and it shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a three-fourths aye and nay vote of the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, this 20th day of February, 1956.
