

ORDINANCE NO. 4787

AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING CERTAIN REAL ESTATE IN THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON, FOR A PUBLIC STREET AND USE OF THE PUBLIC, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I.

The Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, does hereby dedicate to the public and its use as a street, the territory within the bounds of the following description: Situated in City of Klamath Falls, Klamath County, Oregon:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southeast corner of Loma Linda Heights, thence North 0° 40' East along the East boundary of said Loma Linda Heights to a point intersecting the East boundary of Loma Linda Drive as proposed to be extended by curve #1 on the official plat of Loma Linda Heights; thence following the East boundary of curve #1 on a radius of 266.6 feet and degree of curve of 21.5° in a Southerly direction to the point of tangency South 82° 54' East a distance of 50.0 feet from the Northeast corner of Lot 32, Loma Linda Heights; thence South 7° 06' West along the tangent to said curve to its intersection with the North boundary of Huron Street, as it is shown on plat before vacation of part thereof; thence westerly along the North boundary of Huron Street to the point of beginning.

Section II.

That the Police Judge of said City is hereby directed to deliver certified copies of this ordinance to the following County officials of Klamath County, Oregon, to-wit: The County Clerk for recording in deed records; the County Assessor and County Engineer, for use in their respective offices.

Section III.

The immediate use of this territory for street purposes, being urgent; the immediate enactment of this ordinance is deemed necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in the case of this ordinance and it shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a three-fourths aye and nay vote of the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, this 27th day of February, 1956.
