This patent is issued under authority of Section one of the Act of June 25, 1910 (36 Stat. 855), and is subject to the reservation of all subsurface rights, except water, to the heirs of Alice Riggs, and to their heirs and assigns, under the terms approved by the Secretary of the Interior, March 25, 1946, pursuant to said Act.

This patent is issued in lieu of Patent No. 1155345, dated November 2, 1955, which has been canceled because of an error in the description.
