To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, an Order of the authorized officer of the Bureau of Indian Affairs is now deposited in the Bureau of Land Management, directing that a fee simple patent issue to the claimant
LeRoy Godown, heir of Kate Drew, for the following described land:

Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

T. 36 S., R. 12 E.,

Sec. 10, Lots 1, 2, 7, 8, 9, 10, 15 and $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 16.

The area described contains 150.00 acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, on file in the Bureau of Land Management:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said claimant and to the heirs of the said claimant the Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever. The land covered by this patent is not liable for any debt contracted prior to this date, as provided by Section 5 of the Act of February 8, 1887 (24 Stat., 388, 389), and the amendatory Acts of May 8, 1906 (34 Stat., 182) and June 21, 1906 (34 Stat., 325, 327).

Subject to such rights for road purposes as Klamath County may have under the Act of February 5, 1948 (62 Stat. 17).

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the undersigned authorized officer of the Bureau of Land Management, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of June 17, 1948 (62 Stat., 476), has, in the name of the United States, caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the Bureau to be hereunto affixed.
