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# LAND STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Act of February 8, 1887 (24 Stat. L. 388-9), Trust Patent No. 842172, dated January 10, 1922, was issued to OLSEN CHARLIE, Klamath allottee No. 992, for lands described as NE 1/4 and Lot 7 sec. 34, E4SE 1/4 sec. 33, T. 34 S., R. 7 E. W.M., Oregon, containing 159.02 acres, more or less.

This report continued to show the chain of title to that part of Lot 7 sec. 34, T. 34 S., R. 7 E., W.M., Oregon, that was purchased by Wynona Wood Jones, Klamath allottee No. 1336, containing 1.6094 acres, more or less, which land is described by metes and bounds in the following paragraph 1.

1. There have been subsequent transactions, since issuance of the above patent, affecting acreage or ownership, other than probate.

(a) Deed Noncompetent Indian Lands, Form 5-183a, executed on April 5, 1928, by Oleen Charlie, a single man, conveying in trust for Wynona Wood Jonah lands described as follows: Starting at a point on the southeast boundary of right of way of the Chiloquin-Williamson River Market Road 24.96 chains south and 3.162 chains west from the northeast corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 34, T. 34 S., R. 7 E., W.M., Oregon; thence south 4.07 chains; thence west 4.39 chains to a point intersecting the southeast boundary of the said road; thence north 47' 12" east following the southeast boundary of said road 5.99 chains to the starting point, containing 0.7794 acres, more or less. Deed contains the following clause: Subject to the condition that while the title is in the grantee or heirs the land herein described shall not be alienated or encumbered without the consent of the Secretary of the Interior. Deed approved on June 20, 1928, by John H. Edwards, Assistant Secretary of the Interior. Recorded in Deed Book Noncompetent Indian Lands, Vol. 55, page 64, Office of Indian Affairs, Land Division.

(b) Indian Deed Inherited Lands, Form 5-183, executed on August 1, 1929, by Abraham Charlie and Mildred Charlie, husband and wife, heirs of Olsen Charlie (Probate 10143-29), conveying in trust for Wynona Wood Jonah lands described as follows: Starting at a point 10 chains south from the northeast corner of the SW 1/4 sec. 34, T. 34 S., R. 7 E., W.M., Oregon; thence west 8.67 chains to the Chiloquin-Williamson River Market Road; thence north 47° 12' east 1.4 chains following the said road; thence east 7.55 chains; thence south 1.03 chains to the starting point, containing 0.83 acres, more or less. Deed contains the following clause: Subject to the condition that while the title is in the grantee or heirs the land herein described shall not be alienated or encumbered without the consent of the Secretary of the Interior. Deed approved on September 25, 1925, by Joseph M. Dixon, First Assistant Secretary of the Interior. Recorded in Deed Book, Inherited Indian Lands, Vol. 57, page 199, Office of Indian Affairs, Land Division.
