WITNESSETH, That said part 1st of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of
Nine Thousand Five Hundred (\$9,500.00) and No/100 dollars,
in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey
unto said part y of the second part the following-described real estate and premises situated in
Klamath County, State of Oregon
on the Klamath Indian Reservation, to wit: NW 1/4 sec. 36, T. 36 S.,
R. 11 E., W.M., Oregon, containing 160 acres, more or less. This conveyance is made
pursuant to the provisions of the Act of May 27, 1902 (32 Stat. 275; 25 U.S.C. 379).
~~There is reserved from the lands hereby granted a Fire Road running north and south~~
~~on the west boundary and a Fire Road running north and south on the east boundary~~
~~constructed by the United States, with the rights of the United States to maintain,~~
~~operate, or improve the same so long as needed or used for or by the United States. (~~

~~is conveyed subject to any existing easements for public roads and highways, for public~~
