## The United States of America

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, an Order of the authorized officer of the Bureau of Indian Affairs is now deposited in the Bureau of Land Management, directing that a fee simple patent issue to the claimants, Leroy Gienger and Elvina Gienger, purchasers of land included in the allotment of Ida Hook, described as follows:

Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

T. 34 S., R. 7 E.,

Sec. 28, NE<sup>1</sup>SE<sup>1</sup>4.

The area described contains 40.00 acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, on file in the Bureau of Land Management:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said claimants and to the heirs of the said claimant, the Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature; thereunto belonging, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimants forever.

This patent is issued under authority of Section one of the Act of June 25, 1910 (36 Stat. 855), and is subject to the reservation of all subsurface rights, except water, to the heirs of Ida Hook, their heirs and assigns, together with the right to lease, extract and retain the same under the terms approved by the Secretary of the Interior, March 25, 1946, pursuant to said Act.

Subject to such rights for power transmission line purposes as the California Oregon Power Company may have under the Act of March 4, 1911 (36 Stat. 1253), as amended (43 U.S.C. Sec. 961).

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the undersigned authorized officer of the Bureau of Land Management, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of June 17, 1948 (62 Stat., 476), has, in the name of the United States, caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the Bureau to be hereunto affixed.
