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the 16th. day of February, 1958; the title of said resolution being more particularly set forth and described as follows:

"A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A COUNCIL MANAGER ADMINISTRATION OF THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON, AND PROVIDING FOR A CHANGE IN THE MANNER OF READING ORDINANCES FOR ADOPTION; AMENDING THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY SO THAT ORDINANCES AND PROPOSITIONS MAY BE ADOPTED; CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING ON THE PROPOSITION; PROVIDING A BALLOT TITLE FOR THE QUESTION TO BE SUBMITTED; DIRECTING THE PRINTING AND PUBLICATION OF ELECTION NOTICES; AND DETERMINING ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO BE DONE IN CONNECTION WITH SAID SPECIAL ELECTION."

AND WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, feels it necessary and proper that a special election be called for the purpose of submitting a charter amendment and proposition, providing for, a Council Manager Administration for Klamath Falls, and for reading of proposed ordinances before adoption, and to amend the Charter of said City so that the objectives and purpose of said resolution may be accomplished; to the qualified voters of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon; it is

RESOLVED, that the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, Ordains as follows:

Section I.

A special election shall be held in the several wards of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, on the 16th. day of May, 1958, at which election the charter amendment and proposition; providing for a Council Manager Administration for Klamath Falls, and for reading of proposed ordinances before adoption, and to amend the Charter of said City so that the objectives and purpose of said resolution may be accomplished; adopted by the Common Council and submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, by resolution, and which, by the terms thereof, are referred to the people, and all charter amendments and/or propositions that may be proposed by said resolution of the Common Council, shall be and hereby are referred to the qualified electors of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, for their approval or rejection. The polls for such election shall be opened at eight o'clock in the forenoon and shall remain open until eight o'clock in the afternoon of said day, and the votes cast on such amendment and proposition shall be counted, canvassed, returned and declared in the manner

provided by the laws of Oregon, the said City Charter and said Ordinance No. 4563.

Section II.

That at said election, there shall be submitted to the qualified electors for their approval or rejection the charter amendment and proposition and resolution heretofore mentioned, the title of which is set out in full in this ordinance.

Section III.

That the ballot title for such charter amendment and proposition shall be as follows, to-wit:

The City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of said election by publishing notices of in the Klamath Falls, Oregon, City Official News-Paper, and by public announcement 15 days immediately preceding said election, May 16, 1958, which notices shall contain the title of such proposition and resolution and the ballot title and which, in full, to be voted upon, the place of voting at the election, and the time when the polls shall be open, including the hour of opening and closing of the polls; together, the notices, or printing notices as provided by Section 48 of the City Charter twenty days prior to said election.
