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RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED - CORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that ORION MILLMEACH CORPORATION, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Nevada, hereinafter called the "Grantor" for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant and convey to the United States of America, acting by and through the Forest Service, U.S.D.A., and assigns, hereinafter called the "Government," an easement and right-of-way, including the right, privilege and authority to locate, construct, maintain, patrol and repair a roadway for access to Government lands and electric and telephone transmission lines serving Government lands, over, along and across the following described real property:

Containing E. 1/4, W. 1/4, SE. 1/4, and SW. 1/4, Section 19, T2N, R2E, Section 19, Township twenty-eight (28) south, Range seven (7) East, Millmeach Meridian.

The said strip being 66 feet in width on one side of a center line to be located and to be constructed on the ground, with a total width of 132 feet, the said center line being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the south boundary of Section 19, Township 28 South, Range 7 East, W. 1/4, approximately 66 feet north of the southeast corner of said Section 19, said point being on the center line of existing Section 19, thence in a northerly direction over and across the NW. 1/4 of said Section approximately 132 feet to a point on the north boundary of said Section approximately 66 feet westerly from the northeast corner of said Section; thence in a northerly direction over and across the SE. 1/4, SW. 1/4, and E. 1/4 of Section 19, Township 28 South, Range 7 East W. 1/4, approximately 5900 feet to a point on the center line of proposed Road 2232A approximately 722 feet southerly and 2165 feet easterly from the northeast corner of said Section.

Together with reasonable parts of all parts, parcels and pieces to and from said lands for the uses designated.
