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EASEMENT FOR RIGHT OF WAY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the
State of Oregon, acting by and through the State Board
of Education, hereinafter called the Grantor, for and
in consideration of FORTY-SIX and 62/100 (\$46.62) DOLLARS
to it paid by the Klamath Forest Protective Association,
FORTY-SIX and 62/100 (\$46.62) DOLLARS to it paid by the
Weyerhaeuser Company, a corporation, and FORTY-SIX and
62/100 (\$46.62) DOLLARS to it paid by Maude E. Liskev,
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these
presents grant unto said Klamath Forest Protective
Association and Weyerhaeuser Company, a corporation,
their successors and assigns, and Maude E. Liskev, her
heirs, executors and assigns, a right of way and easement
for roadway purposes, to be used by said Grantees
in common, over a certain strip of land 40 feet wide,
situated in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, and
