NOW KNOW YE, that there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said claimant the tract of land above described, and to the heirs and assigns of
the said claimant, forever subject to any vested and defined water rights for mining, agriculture, manufacturing, or other purposes, and
rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local, state, federal, laws,
and decisions of courts and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way for ditches or canals constructed by the
authority of the United States.
