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EASEMENT DEED 4 pages

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Lewis Kandra and Edith Kandra, his wife, hereinafter called the "Grantor", do hereby grant and convey to the United States of America, acting by and through the Forest Service, U.S.D.A., and assigns hereinafter called the "Government", an easement and right-of-way, including, but not limited to, the right, privilege and authority to locate, construct, relocate, maintain, patrol and repair a roadway and electric and telephone transmission lines over, upon, along and across the following described real property situated in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, to wit:

"A strip of land sixty-six feet in width traversing the following described real property:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 33 South, Range 14 East, W.M.

The said strip being 33 feet in width on each side of a center line of a road as located and to be constructed on the ground, with as much additional width as required for adequate protection of cuts and fills, said center line being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the south boundary of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, T. 33 S., R. 14 E., W.M., 2640 feet southerly and 1030 feet westerly from the northeast corner of said section, thence in a northeasterly direction over and across the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ approximately 1140 feet to a point on the east boundary of said section 2300 feet southerly from the northeast corner of said section.

Commencing at a point on the west boundary of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, T. 33 S., R. 14 E., W.M., 2300 feet southerly from the northwest corner of said section, thence in a northeasterly direction over and across the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ approximately 1315 feet to a point on the present Sycon Marsh road in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, which point is approximately 1400 feet southerly and 530 feet easterly from the northwest corner of said section.

Together with reasonable rights of ingress, egress and regress to and from said lands for the purpose designated.

7 The rights, privileges and authorities herein granted are for full use and enjoyment by the Government for any and all purpose deemed necessary or desirable in connection with the control, management and administration of the National Forest, or the resources thereof, and, in so far as compatible therewith, use by the general public and the rights, privileges and authorities herein granted shall continue as long as used for the purposes granted but if for a period of three years the Government shall cease to use the rights, privileges and authorities for the purposes granted or shall abandon the use of the easement herein granted then
