heirs and assigns, all the following real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances situated
in the County of Klamath and State of Oregon, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning on the southerly line of Portland Street at the northeasterly corner of Lot 6, Block 17, HOT SPRINGS ADDITION to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, thence southerly along the line between Lots 5 and 6 of said Block 17 a distance of 96.2 feet to a stake; thence westerly at right angles a distance of 32.1 feet to a stake; thence northerly 98.3 feet to the southerly line of Portland Street at a point midway between the northeasterly corner and the northwesterly corner of said Lot 6; thence easterly along the southerly line of Portland Street 39.1 feet to the point of beginning, being a portion of Lot 6 in Block 17 HOT SPRINGS ADDITION aforesaid.
