EASEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That CROWN ZEL-
LERBACH CORPORATION, a Nevada corporation, hereinafter
called the "Grantor", for and in consideration of the sum of
Eight and 75/100 Dollars (\$8.75), the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant to THE UNITED STATES
OF AMERICA, hereinafter called the "Grantee", and its assigns,
a permanent easement on a strip of land 66 feet in width for
a right of way and road in the South 1/2 of Section 34, Town-
ship 30 South, Range 7 East, W.M., Klamath County, Oregon,
and upon which the Grantee may construct, reconstruct, im-
prove, use, operate, patrol and maintain a road known as the
"Boundary Spur Road, Project Number 30011", and the right to
cut and use any lodgepole timber growing thereon. The said
strip being 33 feet in width on each side of a centerline as
located and to be constructed on the ground, with as much ad-
ditional width as required for adequate protection of cuts and
fills, the said centerline being located and described as
shown on "Exhibit A" which is attached hereto and made a part
hereof and is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Engineer's centerline Station
0+00, a point 577.17 ft. northerly and 1821.07 ft.
westerly of the southeast section corner of Sec-
tion 34, T. 30 S., R. 7 E., W.M., near which point
centerline enters property of the Grantor, extend-
ing and shortening the side lines so as to origi-
nate at the edge of right-of-way of State Highway
232, thence along the Engineer's centerline N 73°
57' W, 1000 ft. to Station 10+00; thence N 73°
50' W, 1900 ft. to Station 29+00; thence N 64° 06'
W, 537.8 ft. to Station P.C. 34+37.8; thence along a
14° 00' curve to the left a distance of 213.2 ft.
