TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said easement for right of way unto said Grantees, their heirs, successors and assigns forever, subject, however, to the following reservations and condition.

The right of way easement herein granted is not an exclusive easement, but is subject to an equal right on the part of the State Board of Higher Education, on behalf of Oregon Technical Institute, its representatives and employees, and the Oregon State Police, its officers and representatives, including the Oregon State Highway Department, as well, of ingress and egress over the said right of way, which right of way is hereby expressly reserved to the parties designated in this paragraph.

This instrument is executed pursuant to chapter 622, Oregon Laws 1959, and pursuant to and in conformance with the provisions of a certain Consent Instrument entered into by and between the United States of America, acting by and through the Secretary of Health, Education and Welfare, and the State of Oregon, acting by and through the State Board of Higher Education, dated the 10th day of September, 1962.
