O R D E R

THIS MATTER coming on before the Court upon the petition of
MELVIRA TOTHAGEN; and,

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT:

That George DuVall died intestate, on or about the 6th day of
September, 1960, in the County of Harney, State of Oregon;

That the said deceased, George DuVall, at the time of his death
was an inhabitant of the County of Marion, State of Oregon; that said
deceased left assets in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, consisting
of personal property (cash) of the value of about \$609.00 and that said
decedent was an enrolled member of the Klamath Indian Tribes and has an
undivided and undetermined interest in the assets of the Klamath Tribes
of the Klamath Indian Reservation in Klamath County, Oregon, which is
under liquidation in accordance with Public Law 587, as passed by the
Congress of the United States of America, and that the value of the said
interest at the present time is computed at \$43,700.00; that the annual
amount of income to this estate, together with the personal property of
the decedent, will not exceed \$1,000.00.

That the petitioner, Melvira Torthagen, is a resident and in-
habitant of the State of Oregon and is a daughter of said deceased,
and is, in all respects, qualified to act as Administratrix herein;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that MELVIRA TOTHAGEN be, and
she hereby is, appointed Administratrix of the estate of George
DuVall, deceased, and that Letters of Administration be granted
to her upon her filing a bond in the sum of \$1,000.00, which said
bond shall be sufficient until such time as additional funds or
property come into said estate at which time an additional bond
will be required to the extent of the property coming into the
hands of the Administratrix.
