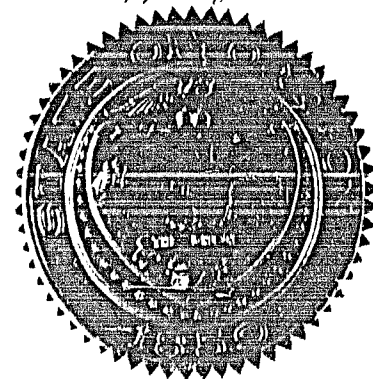


Notarial Commission
