


# Notarial Commission

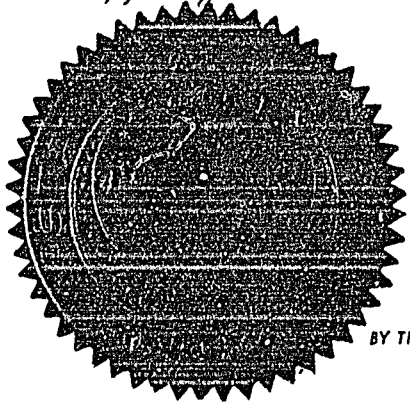
To all to Whom These Presents Shall Come-Greeting:
