An undivided one-half (1/2) interest in and to the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Eight (8), Township Thirty-Three (33), Range Seven and one-half (7 $\frac{1}{2}$), E.W.M.; the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and Lots One (1) and Two (2), Section Nine (9), Township Thirty-Three (33), Range Seven and one-half (7 $\frac{1}{2}$), E.W.M.;

The purpose of this deed is to create an estate by the entirety between GRANTOR and GRANTEE, wife and husband.

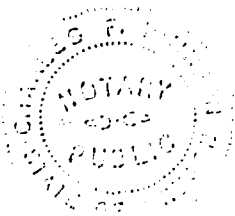
