

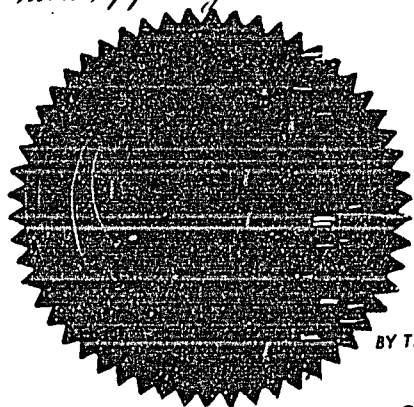


Notarial Commission
