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
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


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that CORPORATION OF THE PRESIDING BISHOP OF THE CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST OF LATTER-DAY SAINTS, a Utah corporation sole, Grantor, in consideration of TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS and other good and valuable consideration, in hand paid, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto WOODROW W. CAVE and ROBERTA E. CAVE, his wife, of Klamath County, State of Oregon, as joint tenants and not as tenants in common, Grantees, the following described real estate, situated in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the west boundary of Section 7, Township 40 South, Range 10 East, Willamette Meridian, which point is S. $0^{\circ}12\frac{1}{2}$ E., 657 feet from the northwest corner of said Section 7; thence S. 0° $12\frac{1}{2}$ E., along said section line, a distance of 1634.0 feet, to a point which is N. 0°12 $\frac{1}{2}$ W., 346.0 feet from the southwest corner of the NW_{4}^{1} of said Section 7 and which point is the northwest corner of a parcel of land shown as "PARCEL TWO" in a deed from J. Clyde Griffith, et ux, to Buford M. Kaylor, et ux, recorded in Klamath County Deed Records, Volume 180, Page 128; thence S. $89^{\circ}54\frac{1}{2}$ E., along the north boundary of said "PARCEL TWO", which line is parallel to the north boundary of said Section 7, a distance 89°54½¹ E., 1452.0 feet; thence N. 0°12½¹ W., 1474.0 feet; thence or less, to the low water mark on the west bank of Lost River; thence N. 47°39¹ W., along said low water fine, 597.0 feet; thence $89^{\circ}54\frac{1}{2}$ E., 1452.0 feet; thence N. $0^{\circ}12\frac{1}{2}$ W., 1474.0 feet, line, N. 11°20' E., 440.0 feet, more or less, to the north boundary of said Section 7; thence N. 89°54 $\frac{1}{2}$ W., along said section boundary, a distance of 943.0 feet, more or less, to the northeast corner of a parcel of land deeded by Karl F. Dehlinger, et us, to Innis Roberts, et ux, and described in a deed in Klamath County Deed Records, Volume 260, Page 25; thence S. $17^{\circ}29^{1+}_{2}$ E. along the east boundary of said Innis Roberts property, a distance of 682.0 feet; thence S. 89° 39½1 W., along the south boundary of said Innis Roberts property, a distance of 1019.5 feet more or less to the point of beginning, being a portion of the NW of Sec. 7, T. 40 S., R. 10 E.W.M., containing 92.0 acres, more or less, SAVING AND EXCEPTING a parcel of land deeded by Karl F. Dehlinger, et ux, to the State of Oregon for highway purposes and described in a deed recorded in Klamath County Deed Records, Volume 232, Page 421, containing 0.18 of an acre.

Subject to waiver of Riparian Rights, including the terms and provisions thereof, from E. C. Ream to the United States, recorded September 16, 1905 in Book 18 at page 334, Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon.

Subject to Agreement, including the terms and provisions thereof, contained in Contract to sell Real Estate, from E. C. Ream, et ux, to L. B. Davison, recorded November 29, 1911 in Book 35 at page 293, Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon, as follows: "It is agreed and understood that the irrigation canal crossing the premises herein described shall be maintained in its present condition unless it shall be changed by mutual agreement by the parties hereto." Subject to recitals, including the terms and provisions thereof, as set out in that certain deed to State of Oregon, by and through its State Highway Commission, dated June 14, 1949, recorded July 16, 1949 in Book 232 at page 421, Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon.

Subject to all covenants and rights-of-way of record.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said grantee and to their heirs and assigns and the grantor named herein does covenant with the grantees named herein and with their heirs and assigns that it is lawfully seized of said premises; that it is free from incumbrance and that the said grantor has good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and that it will and its successors and assigns shall Warrant only against all acts of itself and its successors and assigns, and by these presents forever Defend the same unto the grantee named herein and unto

Subject to acceptance of the terms and conditions of

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their heirs and assigns and forever against the lawful claim of all persons whomsoever.
