POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT HUMBLE OIL & REFINING COMPANY, a Delaware corporation having an office in Houston, Texas, hereinafter referred to as "Company," acting by and through its undersigned officer, hereunto duly authorized, does hereby revoke all powers of attorney previously granted by it to J. F. FLEMING, and does hereby nominate, constitute and appoint J. F. FLEMING its true, sufficient and lawful agent and attorney in fact on behalf of the Company and in its name, place and stead from time to time in connection with the business of the Company to execute and deliver instruments of any and every nature, including but not by way of limitation, instruments pledging the credit of the Company, documents (including permits, applications, bids, representations, contracts and other instruments) delivered to any governmental instrumentality or political entity or subdivision, bonds, indemnities, contracts, leases of real or personal property, deeds of conveyance, encumbrances, releases and transfers of leasehold estates and other interests in real and personal property, including mineral interests, and affidavits, proofs of claims and other instruments used in any court proceeding; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that he shall have no power or authority to execute or deliver any of the following:

- (1) Any mortgage or conveyance in fee of the Company's real property valued at more than one million dollars by any taxing authority; and
- (2) Any mortgage, assignment, release or transfer of any interest in property productive of oil, gas or other minerals.

The execution and delivery of said instruments by such agent and attorney in fact in pursuance of these presents shall be as binding upon the Company, as fully and amply, to all intents and purposes, as if such instruments had been duly executed and delivered by an executive officer of the Company.

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This Power of Attorney shall be effective on and after the date hereof and shall have the same force and effect as though special authority was granted to the named agent and attorney in fact to execute and deliver each such instrument separately for each and every such instrument so executed and delivered.
