WHEREAS, the Klamath County Board of Commissioners has received a duly recorded petition to improve Bisbee Street from Boardman Avenue to Cannon Avenue, and

WHEREAS, letters calling for remonstrances against the project were mailed to each affected property owner of record, and

WHEREAS, less than 50% of the property owners representing less than 50% of the abutting property have remonstrated against the proposed improvement.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above named street be improved by force account. This Order is notice that the land abutting on the improvement to be made is subject to a lien of an assessment for the cost of the improvement in an amount to be determined later by an Order of the Board of County Commissioners. This Order shall be recorded and indexed in the Lien Docket in the office of the County Clerk.
