

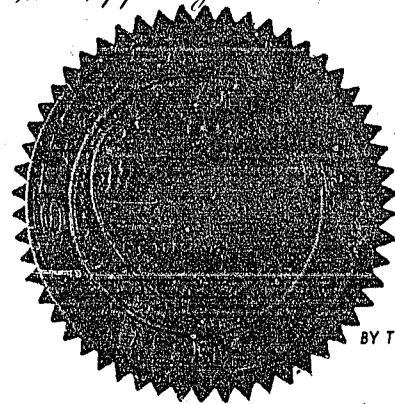


Notarial Commission

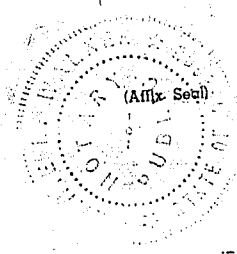
