

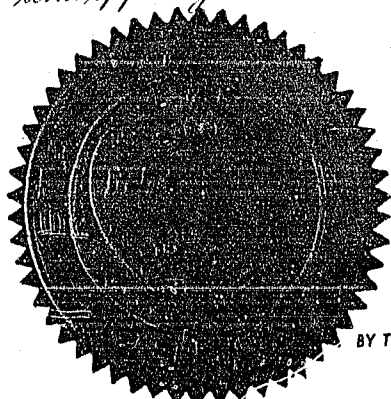


Notarial Commission

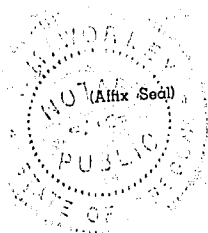
