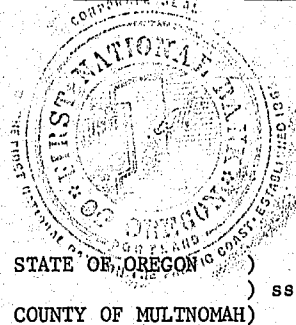
Lot 8 in Summers Park according to the duly recorded plat thereof on file in Klamath County, Oregon
