> The East 53.46° of Lot 7, and the West 20° of Lot 8, Block 38, Klamath Falls original, duly recorded plat and was on file at the office of the County Clerk of Klamath County, Gregon.

That at the time claimant commenced to furnish said labor and materials Keith L.
