NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and agree-

ments hereinafter contained, it is understood and agreed as follows:

Each of the parties hereto may occupy, without being held for trespass, the right of way and easement which each of said parties has secured from the record

title holders of the property hereinabove described.

Before installing, erecting or altering any of the facilities which either of the parties may have upon said rights of way, each party shall first secure the written consent of the other party. Such consent shall not be withheld arbitrarily but shall be withheld only for good cause.

This agreement is intended to allow the parties hereto to beneficially occupy the rights of way which each has with as little interference with the other's facilities and use of said rights of way as possible and with as little interference and inconvenience to the record title holders' use and occupancy of said lands.
