ANTENUPTIAL AGREEMENT

I

This agreement is entered into on ^{MAY} 3, 1966, ¹⁹⁶⁶
between RICHARD DUDLEY TAYLOR and CHRISTINE ADELINE CAMPBELL.

II

RECITALS

A. RICHARD DUDLEY TAYLOR and CHRISTINE ADELINE CAMPBELL
are contemplating marriage.

B. CHRISTINE ADELINE CAMPBELL is the owner of the following
described real and personal property which is of a substantial
value and is her separate property.

1. U.S. Savings Bonds, serial H, dated June 1, 1958
due June 1, 1968.
2. U.S. Treasury Note, 4 1/4% dated May 15, 1964, due
May 15, 1974.
3. U.S. National Bank of Oregon common trust fund,
1100 shares.
4. Real property located in Klamath County, Oregon
described as follows: South 1/2, southwest 1/4
Section 22, north 1/2, northwest 1/4 Section 27,
Township 30 south, Range 8, East Willamette
Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, as recorded
in recorders office of Klamath County, Oregon.
5. Real property located in Klamath County, Oregon
described as follows: South 1/2, southeast 1/4
Section 21, north 1/2, northeast 1/4, Section
28, Township 30 south, Range 8, East Willamette
Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, as recorded
in recorders office of Klamath County, Oregon.
6. Real property located in Klamath County, Oregon
described as follows: South 1/2, northwest 1/4,
north 1/2, southwest 1/4 Section 27, Township
30 south, East Willamette Meridian, Klamath County,
Oregon, as recorded in recorders office of Klamath
County, Oregon.
7. Real property located in Klamath County, Oregon
described as follows: Lots 3 and 4, south 1/2,
northeast 1/4, southwest 1/4, north 1/2, southeast
1/4, southwest 1/4, northwest 1/4, southeast 1/4,
Section 31, Township 32 south, Range 9, East
Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon.

8. Cash on hand with Trust Office, U.S. National Bank of Oregon.

9. Savings Account, U.S. National Bank of Oregon.

C. The parties desire to define their respective rights of each in the property of the other after marriage.

D. The parties desire that all of the property owned by either of them at the time of their marriage, including income, rents and profits from said property, shall be their respective separate property.

III

AGREEMENT

A. RICHARD DUDLEY TAYLOR hereby waives, discharges, and releases any and all claims and rights, title, or interest whatsoever that he may acquire by reason of the marriage in the above mentioned separate property of CHRISTINE ADELINE CAMPBELL set out in paragraph II B above, including income, interest, rents or profits from said property.

B. RICHARD DUDLEY TAYLOR further waives, discharges and releases any and all rights to share in any capacity or to any extent in the estate of CHRISTINE ADELINE CAMPBELL, whether by way of family allowance, probate, homestead, or otherwise or to act as administrator of her estate except under a Will executed subsequent to the effective date hereof.

C. A consideration for this agreement is the contemplated marriage between the parties.

D. Each party shall, at the request of the other execute, acknowledge and deliver whatever additional instruments may be required in order to accomplish the intent of this agreement.

E. This agreement shall bind the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors and administrators. This agreement

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shall be operative only in the event that the contemplated marriage between the parties shall be solemnized.

This agreement was executed on this 3rd day of May, 1966.

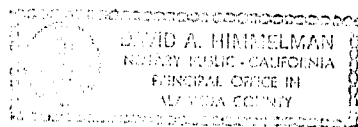
