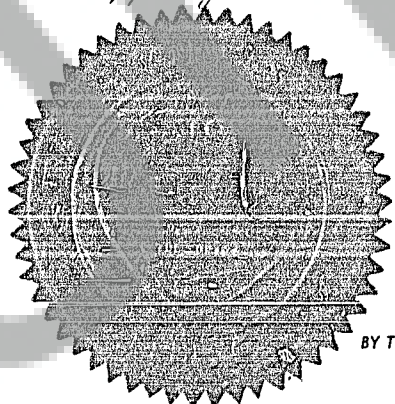


Notarial Commission

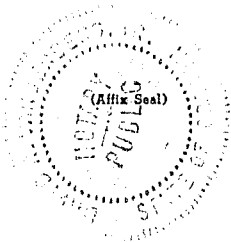
