



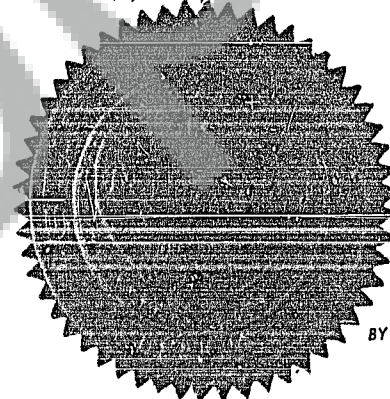
Notarial Commission
