have granted, bargained, and sold and by these presents 300 hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and PORTLAND GENERAL ELECTRIC COMPANY, an Oregon corporation, each an undivided one-half interest, hereinafter collectively called the "Grantees", and their assigns, a permanent easement and right of way approximately 14 feet in width, with such additional widths as are necessary to provide for cuts, fills, and turnouts and for curves at the angle points, all over and across the lands of the Grantor in a portion of the SW_SE_4 of Section 12, Township 36 South, Range 12 East, Willamette meridion, Klamath County, crogen, except any portion thereof which lies within the right of way of the United States of America for its Sonneville Power Administration's transmission liner, and which lies within the right of way for Portland General Electric Company's transmission line,

for the following purposes, namely: The right to enter and to clear of timber and brush; the right to grade, level, cut, fill, drain, build, surface, maintain, repair and rebuild a road(\mathfrak{s}) and such culverts, bridges, turnouts, retaining walls, or other appurtenant structures as may be necessary; and the right to use said road(\mathfrak{s}) on, over, and across the land embraced within the right of way, as shown colored in red, on the attached right of way map(\mathfrak{s}) serially numbered 176324 DN-2.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said easement and right of way unto said Grantees and their assigns, forever.

It is further understood and agreed by the Grantor that the payment of such purchase price is accepted as full compensation for all damages incidental to the exercise of any of the rights above described.

Grantor covenants with the Grantees that Grantor is lawfully seized and possessed of the lands aforesaid; has a good and lawful right and power to sell and convey the same; that the same are free and clear of all encumbrances; and that Grantor will forever warrant and defend the title thereto and quiet possession thereof against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
