RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

INCLUDING the right to clear said right of way and keep the same clear of brush, trees, timber and structures; the right to clear and cut away all trees outside of said right of way which might endanger said transmission lines; the right to construct, reconstruct, operate, maintain and remove said lines; the right in the future to construct, reconstruct, operate, maintain and remove additional lines, future to construct, or desirable poles, structures and appurtenances thereto

At no time shall any building or anything flammable be erected or placed within the boundaries of said right of way, nor shall any equipment or material of any kind or nature that exceeds twenty (20) feet in height be placed or used thereon by Grantors, or by Grantors' heirs, successors or assigns.

Subject to the foregoing limitations, said right of way may be used by the Grantors for roads, agricultural crops, or other purposes not inconsistent with said easement.
