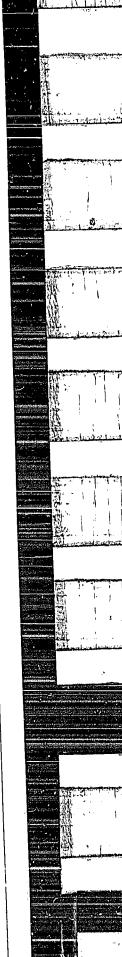

Section 14: That portion of the NEWNEW lying East of Lost River and South of Miller Creek: that portion of the SENNER lying Northeasterly of Lost River as now located. Section 11: That portion of the SE%SE% lying Southwesterly of Miller Creek and Northeasterly of Lost Piver. Section 12: SFMSEM; that portion of the NMSEM lying South of Miller Creek as now located; the SWMSFM EXCEPT that portion lying Northwesterly of Miller Creek as now located; that portion of the SkSWk lying Southeasterly of Lost River. Easement given and granted to Philip Lynch from Bide Steward et ux et al in deed dated July 25, 1966, and recorded August 12, 1966 in Volume M-66 at page 234, Records of Klamath County, Oregon, which said easement is across the West 20 feet of the WiSWiz, Section 7, Township 40 South, Range 14 East of the Willamette Meridian, which said easement was also given and granted to Albert George Keady et ux in deed dated July 25, 1966, and recorded August 12, 1966, in Volume M-66 at page 2278, Records of Elamath County, Oregon. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises with their appurtenances unto the said Crantees as an estate by the entirety. And the said Grantors do hereby covenant to and with the said Grantees, and their assigns, that they are the owners in fee simple of said premises: that they are free from all encumbrances, save and except as above set forth, and that they will warrant and defend the same from all lawful claims whatsoever, except those above set forth.
