

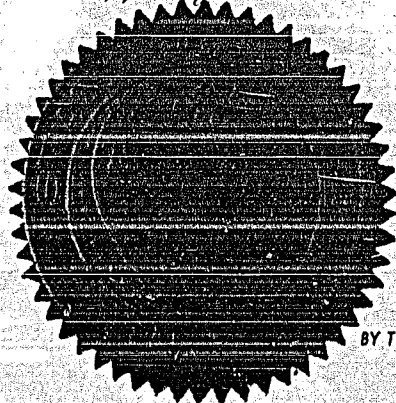


Notarial Commission
