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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Dean J. Hall and Hazel V. Hall, husband and wife

in consideration of -----Ten and no/100-----, hereinafter called the grantor, Dollars

to grantor paid by Orval K. Musgrove and Fern M. Musgrove, husband and wife, hereinafter called the grantees, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the grantees, as tenants by the entirety, the heirs of the survivor and their assigns, that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

Lot 18 in Block 5 of Second Addition To Winema Gardens, according to the official plat thereof on file in the records of Klamath County, Oregon.

Subject to easements and rights of way of record and apparent on the land, to building and use restrictions of record, and to rules, regulations, and assessments of South Suburban Sanitary District.

To Have and to Hold the above described and granted premises unto the said grantees, as tenants by the entirety, their heirs and assigns forever.

And grantor hereby covenants to and with grantees and the heirs of the survivor and their assigns, that grantor is lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, free from all encumbrances except any liens imposed on said real property or permitted to be created by grantees and liens imposed by virtue of street improvements, and subject to taxes for fiscal year 1966-67;

and that grantor will warrant and forever defend the above granted premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
