Musgrove, husband and wife, hereinafter called the grantees, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the grantees, as tenants by the entirety, the heirs of the survivor and their assigns, that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

Subject to easements and rights of way of record and apparent on the land, to building and use restrictions of record, and to rules, regulations, and assessments of the South Suburban Sanitary District.

In construing this deed and where the context so requires, the singular includes the plural. WITNESS grantor's hand and seal this 26th day of October, 1966.

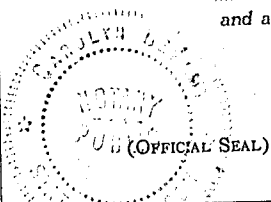
