**INTERLOCUTORY JUDGMENT OF DIVORCE**

This cause came on regularly for hearing on November 17, 1966  
in Department 18, before Judge JOHN A. HEWICKER

Upon proof thereof, it is found that the Court has jurisdiction of the parties; that evidence was introduced at said hearing of this cause; and said cause having been submitted to the Court for its consideration and decision;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Court, having considered the evidence, finds that facts have been proved which entitle the plaintiff to a divorce herein;

WHEREFORE, IT IS ADJUDGED that the plaintiff is entitled to an interlocutory judgment of divorce; that when one year has expired from the date of service of a copy of summons and complaint upon the defendant spouse, the Court on motion of either party hereto, may enter the final judgment granting a divorce, and such final judgment shall restore the parties to the status of single persons and permit either to marry after the entry thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the real property described as Lots 5, 124 Klamath Falls Forest Estates, Highway 66 Unit, Plat number 4, as recorded in the office of County Recorders, Klamath County, Oregon, consisting of 498 net acres, is found to be community property and awarded to plaintiff, PATSY M. McQUIEN.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that defendant, JACK T. McQUIEN, shall save and hold harmless plaintiff from and against all community debts.
