If the road is located substantially as described herein, the centerline of the road as constructed is hereby deemed accepted by the Grantor as the true centerline of the easement granted.

Together with such reasonable rights of temporary use of the Grantor's lands immediately adjacent to said right-of-way as may be necessary for the construction, reconstruction, improvement and maintenance of said road.

The acquiring agency is the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture.

This conveyance is made subject to the following reservations by the Grantor, his heirs and assigns:

- The right to cross and recross the easement at any point and for any purpose in such manner as will not materially interfere with the use of the road.
- 2. The Grantee will permit the Grantor, his heirs and assigns, to use the road to serve his property in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture³⁶C.F.R. 212.7 - 212.11, as the same may be amended, in such manner as not unreasonably to interfere with its use by the United States, its authorized users or assigns, or cause substantial injury thereto.

Provided, however, that if for a period of five years the Grantee shall cease to use the road, or parts thereof, for the purposes granted, or shall abandon the same, then, in any such events, the premises traversed thereby shall be freed from said easement, or parts thereof, as fully and completely as if this deed had not been made. In the event of such non-use for the period stated, the Regional Forester shall furnish to the Grantor a statement in recordable form evidencing such non-use. 30
