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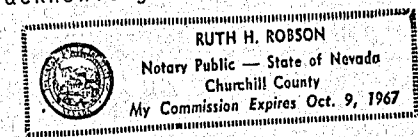
clear from all encumbrances, and it will, and its successors shall warrant and defend the same and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.

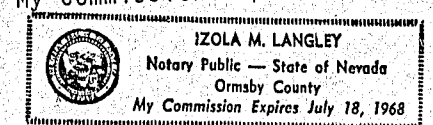
