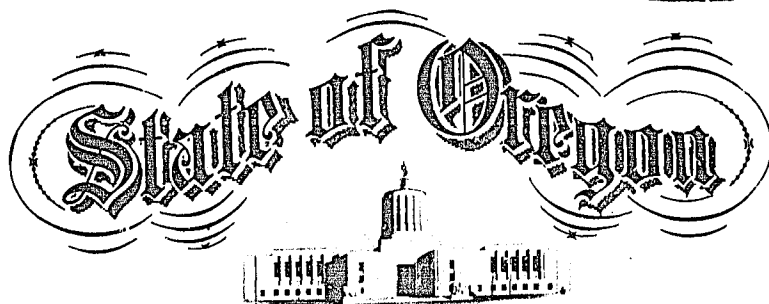


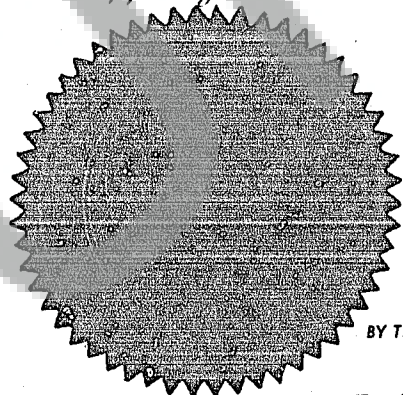


Notarial Commission
