RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT DEED - INDIVIDUAL

THIS DEED, dated this at day of 5, by and between Vance Hall and Barbara Taylor Hall, his wife, Mereinafter called the "Grantor," and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter called the "Grantee."

WITNESSETH, that the Grantor, for and in consideration of \$1.00, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant and convey unto the Grantee and it assigns an exclusive easement for a fence including cattle guard and gates to be located, constructed, re-constructed, improved, used, patrolled and maintained, and known as the Blaisdell South Boundary Fence, Project Number 7029, over, upon along and across the following described premises situated in the county of Klamath, State of Oregon, to wit:

A strip of land 10 feet in width traversing the following described real property:

SW15E1 Section 24 NE1NE1 Section 25, T.37S., R.15E., W.M.

The said strip being 5 feet in width on each side of a centerline as located and to be constructed on the ground, with as much additional width as required for adequate protection of the fence, the said centerline being located and described as shown on Exhibit A which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

If the fence is located substantially as described herein, the centerline of the fence as constructed is hereby deemed accepted by the Grantor as the true centerline of the easement granted.

Together with such reasonable rights of temporary use of the Grantor's Lands immediately adjacent to said right-of-way as may be necessary for the construction, re-construction, improvement and maintenance of said fence.

The acquiring agency is the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture.

It is agreed between the parties hereto that the Grantee will:

- a. In the construction and maintenance of said fence, attach such fence to posts or to trees provided that a 2-inch thick piece of wood reaching from the top wire to the bottom wire shall first be nailed to any such tree with non-ferrous nails, and in no event will any fence by attached directly to any tree.
- b. Install a cattleguard at the crossing of Road 3631, and install gates at all other road crossings.

Provided, however, that if for a period of five years the Grantee shall cease to use the fence, or parts thereof, for the purposes granted, or shall abandon the same, then, in any such events, the premises traversed thereby shall be freed from said easement, or parts thereof, as fully and completely as if this deed had not been made. In the event of such non-use for the period stated, the Regional Forester shall furnish to the Grantor a statement in recordable form evidencing such non-use.
