A tract of land situated in the NW<sup>1/4</sup> corner of Section 7, T 39 S, R 9 ENW, Klamath County, Oregon, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Southeasterly boundary of the Ashland State Highway, said point being N 76° 48' E along said boundary a distance of 1198.8 feet from the steel stake marking its intersection with the West line of said NW<sup>1/4</sup> SE<sup>1/4</sup> of Section 7; thence South a distance of 225.2 feet; thence East a distance of 178.6 feet; thence North a distance of 267.1 feet to the Southeasterly boundary of the Ashland State Highway; thence S 76° 48' W along said boundary a distance of 183.4 feet, more or less to the point of beginning, containing 1.01 acres, more or less.
