AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 98 OF KLAMATH ADDITION LOCATED BETWEEN FOURTH AND FIFTH STREETS AND BETWEEN PLUM AND WILLOW STREETS, ALL IN THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS: Section 1.

The Alley in Block 98 of Klamath Addition located between Fourth and Fifth Streets and between Plum and Willow Streets, all in the City of Klamath Falls, are hereby vacated.

Section 2.

Time being of the essence of the aforementioned ordinance, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by a three-fourths aye and may vote of the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.
