CERTIFICATE OF TERMINATION

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On June 1, 1962, Weyerhaeuser Company, a corporation, conveyed to the United States of America an easement, which said easement was recorded in Volume 14, Page 332 of Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon.

Said easement provides for "removal of . . . forest products from National Forest lands."

Said easement expired December 31, 1962.

Said easement was a donation and it has been determined that the Forest Service has no present or foreseeable future needs for said easement and that said easement is not now being used.

A careful appraisal of the easement indicates that it has no market value and is of no value to the Forest Service. Under these circumstances it would appear to be an unreasonable burden on the Forest Service to retain said easement on inventory and said easement is hereby declared terminated by the Forest Service.
