TRUSTEE'S NOTICE OF SALE

Reference is made to that certain trust deed made, executed and delivered by Gerald L. Davidson and Carolyn A. Davidson, as grantors, to Oregon Title Insurance Co., as trustee, to secure certain obligations in favor of First National Bank of Oregon, a national banking association, as beneficiary, dated January 22, 1965, recorded January 27, 1965, in Book 228, page 356, of the Mortgage Records of Klamath County, Oregon, covering the following-described real property situated in said county and state, to wit: Lots 23 and 24, Block 309 DARRROW ADDITION to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, Transamerica Title Insurance Company was appointed successor trustee by a certain instrument dated August 1, 1968, and recorded August 5, 1968 in Volume M-68, page 067, of said Mortgage Records of Klamath County, Oregon, and is now vested with all the powers of said former trustee.

Both the beneficiary and the trustee have elected to sell said real property to satisfy the obligations secured by said trust deed and to foreclose said deed by advertisement and sale; the default for which the foreclosure is made is grantors' failure to pay when due the following sums owing on said obligations, which sums are now past due, owing and delinquent:

Notice is further given that any person named in Section 86.760 of Oregon Revised Statutes has the right to have the foreclosure proceeding dismissed and the trust deed reinstated by pay-

ment of the entire amount due (other than such portion of said principal as would not then be due had no default occurred) together with costs and trustee's and attorneys' fees at any time prior to five days before the date set for said sale.

In construing this notice and whenever the context hereof so requires, the word "grantors" includes any successor in interest to the grantors as well as any other person owing an obligation, the performance of which is secured by said trust deed, and their successors in interest; the word "trustee" includes any successor trustee and the word "beneficiary" includes any successor in interest of the beneficiary named in the trust deed.
