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Recital 1: Whereas by Warranty Deed dated May 6, 1965, recorded May 7, 1965 in Volume 361 of Deeds on page 280, Records of Klamath County, Oregon, Weyerhaeuser Company, a Washington corporation of Tacoma, Washington, Grantor, conveyed to Charles A. Curtiss and Doris Quist Curtiss, Grantees, real property described as follows, to-wit:

PARCEL B

Lot One (1) of Section Four (4), Township Thirty-seven (37) South, Range Seven (7) East of W. M., EXCEPT that portion thereof heretofore conveyed by Weyerhaeuser Timber Company to the State of Oregon by deed dated September 13, 1951, and recorded October 3, 1951 in Book 250, at page 175, Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon;

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING unto Grantor all timber on said described premises until January 1, 1982.

Recital 2: Whereas the timber excepted and reserved on Parcel B above described has now been removed.

THEREFORE, Weyerhaeuser Company, a Washington corporation of Tacoma, Washington, does hereby release and convey to Charles A. Curtiss and Doris Quist Curtiss, husband and wife, all of its right, title and interest in and to the land and timber hereinabove described in Parcel B.

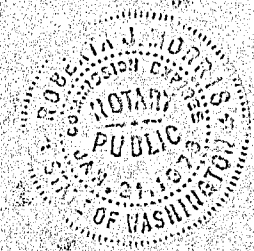
